## COVID-19 Statement

In order to create a Summer Camp that is both fun *and* safe, ASAP's Summer Camp will be following CDC's recommended guidelines regarding childcare, sanitation, and social distancing.

What this looks like:

- Groups of no more than 14 students. Groups will not interact and will have separate bathrooms and indoor spaces. We want to prioritize safety within cohorts, reducing the amount of different students the other students interact with. We want to keep the groups as consistent as possible.
- Frequent hand-washing and sanitation. We will always have hand sanitizer on hand, and ensure kids wash their hands before and after eating.
- Social distancing. When kids are partaking in activities where they will be stagnant (such as crafts, lunch, etc.) we will enforce ample space between them.
- Masks. Masks will be required when children are unable to social distance or are inside. Since it will be Summer, we are hoping for a lot of nice weather, fresh air, and outside play time!
- Flexibility. As data and rules constantly change, ASAP does its best to adapt. We ask that you be patient and flexible with us during these times as well.

ASAP understands the importance of staying safe and healthy! We want to provide an experience for you children that you feel safe and excited about.

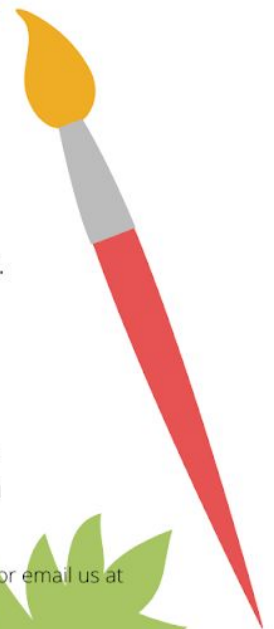
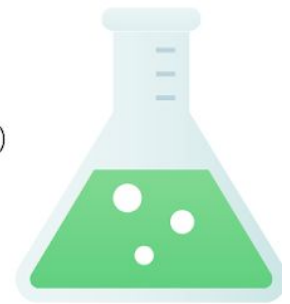
